



# 2018 Winter Code Updates



Wisconsin's regional inspector associations, in cooperation with the Wisconsin Department of Safety & Professional Services, Industry Services Division, are offering training sessions in early 2018 about Wisconsin's Electrical Code, Uniform Dwelling Code, Plumbing Code and Commercial Building Code. These courses can provide continuing education credits for Industry Services administered inspection and DCQ credentials. Fire inspectors, designers, contractors, and others with an interest in Wisconsin's codes may also benefit from the programs.

- **Registrations are handled by the individual inspector associations. Please pay close attention as to which association and mailing address your payment should be sent to.** The association's websites may show the specific program agendas. Confirmations are not sent. Registrations are subject to available space. If a session is full, your registration and monies will be returned. Fees vary due to presentation and venue costs. Please keep a copy of this brochure and your registration form. One registrant per form.
- Registration and fees must be received 1 week prior to the desired day/session, or a late charge of \$10 will be assessed for each day/session. Cancellations must also be received 1 week prior to the session in order to receive a full refund. **All associations accept cash, check or money order only – credit card payments will not be accepted.**
- Registration for all day sessions will start 7:15 a.m. with **programs starting promptly at 7:45 a.m.** The sessions will end at approximately 3:45 p.m. Credential abbreviations noted below are: CBI = Commercial Building Inspector, CEI = Commercial Electrical Inspector, CPI = Commercial Plumbing Inspector, UCI = UDC-Construction Inspector, UHI = UDC-HVAC Inspector, UEI = UDC-Electrical Inspector, UPI = UDC-Plumbing Inspector, DCQ = Dwelling Contractor Qualifier, ME = Master Electrician, JE = Journeyman Electrician, PM = Master Plumber and PJ = Journeyman Plumber.

**Commercial Electrical Code** – This course will cover firestopping installations as well as wireway, enclosure and conductor requirements. Commercial grounding and bonding will also be included. A code panel will cover common commercial electrical code violations. The presentation will include 2017 SPS 316 changes if available at the time of training. See DSPS website <https://dsps.wi.gov/Pages/Programs/ElectricalLighting/Default.aspx> for updates. 6 con ed credit hours for all electrical license categories will be given, including Registered Electrician. The program includes two short breaks in the morning, one break in the afternoon and lunch at noon. Please note any special dietary needs on application.

**1 & 2 Family Electrical Code** – This course will cover drilling, boring and notching wood for electrical installations as well as residential box and conductor requirements. Residential bonding and grounding will also be included. A code panel will cover common residential electrical code violations. The presentation will include 2017 SPS 316 changes if available at the time of training. See DSPS website <https://dsps.wi.gov/Pages/Programs/ElectricalLighting/Default.aspx> for updates. 6 con ed credit hours for all electrical license categories will be given, including Registered Electrician. The program includes two short breaks in the morning, one break in the afternoon and lunch at noon. Please note any special dietary needs on application.

**Evening Electrical Code – Lake Delton** Service Installation requirements for small and large scale services will be reviewed. Equipment and conductor sizing, grounding, bonding, and other installation challenges will also be reviewed. Please bring your 2011 NEC - it will be utilized for an interactive learning experience. An update of the 2017 SPS 316 adoption will be presented if available. 3 con ed credit hours for all electrical license categories (electrician and inspector) including Registered Electrician will be given per night. Dinner prior to the session is included. Please note any special dietary needs on application.

**Uniform Dwelling Code** – In addition to administrative information including Act 211, this course will cover concrete and masonry installations in 1 & 2 family construction as well as common UDC construction issues. A short program on how builders and inspectors assist with electrical compliance will also be included. 6.5 con ed credit hours for UCI, UHI and DCQ. Lunch is included. Please note any special dietary needs on application.

**Commercial Building Code** – In addition to administrative information, this course will focus on the "Wisconsinisms" relating to the upcoming 2015 ICC adoption. Top commercial inspection items will be covered as well as a short program on commercial health care. Randy Dahmen, DSPS, will also provide training on commercial HVAC plan review. 6.5 con ed credit hours for CBI and DCQ. Lunch is included. Please note any special dietary needs on application.

**Plumbing Code** – These courses are being offered separately through the association where listed on the registration form. Plumbing course descriptions as well as credit hour information are noted on the registration form. Questions regarding these courses should be directed to the association's contact person.
