Meeting called to order @9:50

Introduced speaker Ronald Trinidad from 3M fire protection products. Ron did a nice job of outlining a mix of products and the applications of each.

Committee reports:

Rob presented the treasures report, a motion was made to approve the treasures report, it was 2nded and passed.

DSPS report, Jack didn't have much to report on this time, he touched on the wall bracing rules. After some questions and concerns he said that he would try to line up some more training for upcoming meetings.

Old business: Nicole updated us on the inspector's institute, sign ups and what needed to be done to attend.

New business: topic- paying for speakers for our monthly meetings. A discussion took place a continuation of last months meeting. The discussion was about paying up to \$100 per hour of continuing education hour of training. Typical training people charge about \$1000-1500 per event. We discussed opening up our training events to others like we do in the spring training event at rock gardens and to offset some of the training costs by inviting others for a fee. A motion was made to allocate \$1000 per year contingent upon the speakers having DSPS approvals and that they need to send cont. ed. Papers to the state and any unused funds at the end of the year would then go back into the general fund. The motion was seconded and then a discussion took place. The motion was withdrawn. Then a motion was made to have \$2000 in a continuing ed budget that the ed committee can use for speakers that have continuing ed approvals, the final approval of the spending of the funds would be approved by the executive committee and any unused funds at the end of the year would go back into the general fund. That motion was 2nded and passed.

We had a discussion on the annual meeting location in December. The woods location was discussed and a motion was made to hold the December 5th meeting at the Woods golf course with 1 addition meat for the meal and to continue the tradition of prepaying \$15 for registration of the meeting and the check would be given back to the attendee at the door. That motion was 2nded and passed.

A motion was made to adjourn 2nded and passed.
